Bids are hereby invited for Application of Admission to Ratlou Local Municipality's Panel of five (05) Consultants for Professional Engineering (Built Environment) Related Services for the period of three years. Suitably qualified, experienced and accredited Professional Service Providers (Consulting Engineering + Project Management) are requested to submit for the purpose design development, procurement documentation as well as construction monitoring of Municipal Capital Projects.

Compulsory Briefing:

Bid documents will be available at the briefing session at a non-refundable cost of **R 1 500.00**.

Submission of Proposals

Sealed tenders, endorsed as indicated in the Bid Documents must reach the Municipality and be placed in visibly marked Tender boxes at Ratlou Local Municipality Offices on R507, Delareyville Road in Setlagole not later than **11:00 on Friday, 25th January 2019**.

THIS BID IS SUBJECT TO THE PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT POLICY FRAMEWORK ACT AND THE PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATION, 2017, AND THE GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (GCC) AND, IF APPLICABLE, ANY OTHER SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT. An 80/20 preference point system will be applicable to this bid.

The Municipality shall appoint prospective service providers to be on the Municipality's consultant panel based on their qualifications, capacity and work experience. Prospective bidders must accept that the bid will be adjudicated according to the said legislation. Bids will remain valid for 90 (ninety) days.

Only bidders who are registered with the relevant professional bodies will be considered. This requirement will remain in force as long as it is a requirement of the Professional body.


N.B: NO BIDS WILL BE CONSIDERED FROM PERSONS IN THE SERVICE OF THE STATE (as defined in Regulation 44 of the Local Government: Municipal Supply Chain Management Regulations)

No late and faxed proposals found in any other place or those from service providers who have not attended the compulsory briefing session will be considered. If bidding as a Joint Venture, all Joint Venture partners must have attended a Compulsory Briefing Session.

The Municipality reserves the right to accept any Bid or part thereof and does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any Bid. The Council also reserves the right to negotiate further conditions and requirements with the successful bidder.
